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## Adult Participation Covenant Statement

The congregation of St. James United Methodist Church is committed to providing a safe and secure environment for all children, youth and volunteers who participate in ministries and activities sponsored by the church. Volunteers are an essential and valuable component of the ministries of St. James United Methodist Church. The following policy statement reflects our congregation’s commitment to preserving this church as a holy place of safety and protection for all who would enter and as a place in which all people can experience the love of God through relationships with others.

1. No adult who has been convicted of child abuse (sexual, physical or emotional) should volunteer to work with children or youth in any church-sponsored activity.
2. Adult survivors of child abuse need the love and support of our congregation. Any adult survivor who desires to volunteer in some capacity to work with children or youth is encouraged to discuss his/her willingness with one of our church’s ministers before accepting an assignment.
3. All adult volunteers involved with children or youth of our church must have attended St. James United Methodist Church regularly (at least three times a month) for four months.
4. Adult volunteers and staff with children and youth shall observe the “Two Adult” and the “No one-on-one Contact” rules.
5. Adult volunteers with children and youth shall attend Safe Sanctuaries trainings and regular training and educational events provided by the church to keep informed of church policies and state laws regarding child abuse.
6. Adult volunteers with children and youth shall immediately report suspected child abuse to the proper authorities, including the appropriate staff person if the incident occurred during church-related activities.
